**FLOW-LINE COMPLETION ACTIVITIES UNDERWAY**

**November 2, 2007 – Probe Resources Ltd. (TSX-V: PBR) (the “Company”)** today announced that activities to complete the flow-line have commenced on its offshore oil and gas project located in the High Island Area in the Gulf of Mexico (the “High Island Project”).

Republic Petroleum, LLC (the “Operator”) over the past two week period has been engaged in decommissioning the Company’s old flow-line. Poor weather forced the crew back on shore last week but they have since been able to recommence work. The Operator has salvaged and repaired the original riser, flow test, and production facilities so that the same can be moved to and installed at the new destination at the High Island Project.

Bisso Marine Co., the contractor, will be laying the new flow-line and they are expected to mobilize to the High Island Project next week. The permits and filings for the new flow-line were approved by the Minerals Management Service (the applicable federal regulatory agency in the USA) last Friday.

The Operator anticipates the flow-line operation will take approximately ten days to complete once the equipment is in place. Final hook-ups, purging the line, testing the line and putting production to sales will take approximately one to two additional days with all activities contingent on weather conditions.
